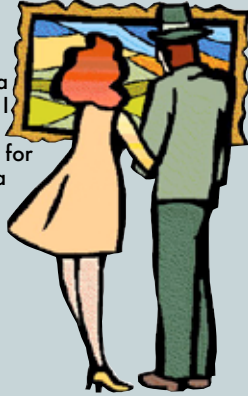


## Eccles Exhibition
